RE: California Proposition 65 Compliance Statement

California Proposition 65 ("Prop 65"), officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, became law in November 1986. Prop 65 requires businesses to give clear and reasonable warnings to Californians if a product or service of the business knowingly and intentionally exposes them to chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm. A warning label is not required, and a business has "safe harbor" from Prop 65, for products containing such chemicals, if: (1) the exposure is below that deemed to pose no significant risk level ("NSRL") for chemicals known to cause cancer, or below the maximum allowable dose level ("MADL") for chemicals known to cause birth defects or reproductive harm; or (2) if the business otherwise determines the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer, birth defects, and other reproductive harm. California has established over 300 safe harbor levels and continues to develop more for such listed chemicals.

As part of our product safety and regulatory compliance program, NG Labs, Inc. dba Headsweats is committed to providing safe, high quality products that comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws. We work closely with our vendors and supply chain partners to ensure our products meet Prop 65 standards and are eligible for a safe harbor exemption from its warning label requirements.
